Accessing applications remotely

Brightspace, Zoom, and YES are applications utilized by the university for remote online learning, collaboration, and communication. These applications are easily accessible using a web browser such as Chrome or Firefox.

To access resources such as file shares or applications that are dependent upon the campus network, you will need to access Vanderbilt's virtual private network (VPN). You may access specific file shares and applications in your labs that require access to the VPN.

There are a few considerations when accessing university applications and resouces:

1. Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) using the Duo application is required to access the VPN and some other university applications. We recommend using the Duo Mobile client on your phone or another handheld device for "Push" approvals.

Zoom may be blocked, as well as streaming media sites like Netflix, Amazon, and Hulu.
